1. Job Description

UNDP Southern Sudan calls for **Expressions of Interest (EOI) from international and national firms**, who have the capacity to formulate, manage, and implement specific components of the Support to Elections and Democratic Processes Project as detailed in the scope of work. Firms and institutions, associations and/or consortiums may express interest in all lots, individual lots or parts thereof. Firms having presence and experience within the region are highly encouraged to participate.. UNDP may enter into Long Term Agreements (LTA) with the short-listed firms following a competitive bidding process.

2. Background

Project Objectives:

The main purpose of the Support to Elections and Democratic Processes Project (SEDP) is to provide assistance to the electoral process in Sudan and to promote the participation of voters and civil society in the process. The Project will provide support to the National Elections Commission (NEC) and its subsidiary bodies – Southern Sudan Elections High Committee, State High Committees, the Political Parties Affairs Council (PPAC), and other stakeholders in the democratic process such as the media and civil society, political parties and domestic observers.

2. Scope of the Work

Background

Support to Elections and Democratic Processes Project is looking for the services of a service provider or logistic management company that provide wide range of logistic support services for organizing of workshops, seminars, events and training events. The provision of logistic services will be required in Southern Sudan in all the States including State Capitals, Counties and Payam levels. This requires the ability of the contractor to arrange different type of events at different areas in all the 10 states of Southern Sudan.

Specific tasks for the designer/contractor

1. Organize the complete logistic arrangements for upto 25-30 workshops, seminars, training sessions and events in Juba.

2. Organize the complete logistic arrangements for around 50-60 workshops, seminars, training sessions and events in all the 10 State Capitals of Southern Sudan.
3. Organize the complete logistic arrangements for around 200-300 workshops and training sessions at County and Payam levels for all the States of Southern Sudan.
4. For all the events the organizing of logistics will include:
 - o Arranging venue for the event
 - o Arrange catering services for the participants
 - o Make available the stationery for the participants
 - o Distribute travel / other allowances to the participants
 - o Invitation for the participants with support from UNDP and partners
 - o Overall management of the event

Qualifications

1. Contractor must be a service provider or a logistic firm with prior experience of similar projects especially organising of large scale events.
2. Contractor must have experience in working in Southern Sudan and familiar with the ground reality.
3. Contractor must guarantee timely delivery of items.

Period

The framework agreement would cover a period depending on the scope and timeline of the events.

3. Information Required in the Response:

The provision of the pre-qualification information should include all relevant documents that are essentially required for the meeting the pre-qualification criteria as well as enable the project management to undertake the evaluation. Service providers must provide the information that they are qualified to perform the services required during the course of the proposed project.

4. Application as a Joint Venture

Service providers may bid in a Joint Venture to enhance their offering. In a joint venture, the companies are jointly and severally responsible for the tasks assigned.. The pre-qualification request must identify one member as prime applicant and must clearly state the role to be played by each member of the joint venture in providing the services envisaged in Section 2 under the scope of work.
